8. \$309.90 for Title One educational materials.
9. \$250.00 for the 5th 5th grade Camp Algonquin Trip.
10. \$600.00 for the teacher's luncheon.

\$400.00 for the nurse's "Learn to eat, Eat to Learn" program passed with one nay and 16 ayes.

The Sock Hop Committee agreed to donate back their \$130.00 of wish list money so that other items could be funded. This brought our total wish list approvals to \$3,000.00.
